**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education is responsible for the approval of a budget that will provide a thorough and efficient education plan, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-5 and 6, N.J.S.A. 18A:7-8 and N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-811 and 9.1 et seq, and,

**WHEREAS,** Governor Christie has proposed the following reductions in state aid without any reduction of rule, regulation or law:
