 - February has been an uneventful month for the Technology Department, partially due to recent weather conditions. We are constantly striving to improve operations and functionality for our users, as well as keeping up with technology trends and ensuring that our state requirements are satisfied.
 - We are introducing a new feature on our website in conjunction with the Assistant Principal's Office for our students to be able to publish their literary

work on our website. We installed a bulletin board system on the site and are working with Mr. Wagner on training teachers and a pilot group of students on its operation. This is a very exciting project which should boost language arts motivation. Similar projects have been successful in other districts, and we look forward to positive results.

- We did have one outage due to the recent record snowfall. The building, as well as much of the borough, lost power for several hours, which is too long for our uninterruptible power supplies' batteries to be able to keep all of our core equipment running. When power was restored, there were a couple of pieces of equipment that did not power back up automatically. Service was restored the next day.
- Finally, as of the time of writing, we are putting the finishing touches on the district Technology Plan and are still on target to submit it to the county office on time.
