- The district will provide professional development opportunities in the areas of Language Arts Literacy, Math, Science, Social Studies, Guided Reading, Learnia, Data Analysis, and Writing. These afterschool workshops will provide teachers with additional strategies to implement into their classroom instruction. This has been place on the BOE agenda for approval. All of the workshops will be funded through the NCLB grant.
- We have completed MAP testing and are beginning to review the data.
- DRA2 testing will be completed by October 29th. This data will be reviewed with each grade level to determine flexible guided reading groups.
- The administration and Title I teachers met with each grade level to discuss the NJASK results for Language Arts Literacy and pacing charts. In the upcoming weeks we will be meeting with each grade level to discuss the NJASK Math results. During these meetings the teachers are able to see the areas of focus for their classes.

Technology

- Technology Department is currently working on the October 15th NJ Smart submissions, which are due November 17th.
- After the state and special education NJ Smart submissions are complete, the district will have to perform NJ Smart's "Pre-ID" submission. This new requirement is supposed to make the NJ ASK setup process smoother.
- Due to relocation, we are expecting to receive some computer equipment from the Children of Promise School. Among other items, there should be a number of desktops and laptops, monitors, a Smart Board, printers, and a projector. We have received some of it already, and are looking forward to distributing it to the classrooms.
- In the coming month, we also want to begin to look at the 2011-2012 budget and possible improvements we can make. These may include centralized storage, new workstations or notebooks, server virtualization software, wireless access points, and other technologies.
